A few days later during a heated conversation in the parking lot at Tyler Joe said this should all be fun and he was not having fun with this anymore. That none of the other presidents questions any of his design decisions. Bob stated that as president it was his job to question everything. It seemed like nothing was reconciled.

Bob set up the Redesign Committee with a rule that a majority was needed on all decisions.

8C position needs to be cemented in When?
